

Thank you to the families that filled in the 'Outdoor Space Audit'. It was great to hear the children's voices and see the fantastic pictures they drew. We are hoping to start work on two new areas outside, this term, we are just waiting for the field to dry out and then we can get started. Watch this space for more details!

Explorers

With school rapidly approaching for our older children, we will be undertaking several 'transition activities' to make it as smooth as possible for them. One of these is helping children separate on drop off. Those children at 'Explorers' in the morning, will now be dropped off at the gate between the red surface and back door. We suggest a positive affirmation that they will be having a lovely day and you will be there to pick them up at the end of the day and then to leave without lingering. We will have three staff outside to support the children and they will be vigilant to any that may need a little extra T.L.C first thing. Please encourage the children to use the toilet before leaving home as this also helps with less children needing to go in and out of our main building before going up to school.



Tuesday Afternoons

For most Tuesday afternoons this term, we have agreed 'Transition Hour' with St Margaret's Primary School. During this time our adjoining gates outside are opened and their Reception children and our afternoon children are free to use both spaces. We also send a couple of staff up to Reception and they do the same with us. We find this is a great tool for successful and smooth transitions and takes away fears



and worries of what school might be like as they will have had so many opportunities to play outside and in, during this term. Even children not going to St Margaret's benefit as they see the free flow set up is similar to ours and will be at other schools, toilets are small and teachers are nice etc.

During the second half of the Summer Term, children going to St Margaret's or other primary schools will also be invited to various play / story times. Please let us know when you do, if your child is leaving early or not coming in as it helps us for grouping and keeping track of all children safely.

Also, at the end of this letter will be a form where you can tell us which primary school your child will be attending and also a tick box to allow us to share information such as Learning Journals to their feeder schools which again, will aid your child having the best possible start to school.

Summer Weather

We are hoping that during this half term the weather will be warming up and the rain will finally stop for a while.

Once the sun does eventually start shining, we ask all children to arrive with a clearly named sunhat which we encourage the children to wear whilst playing outdoors. Shoes should be sensible so that they can run, jump and climb safely; please avoid wellies, crocs, flip-flops or Birkenstock types of sandals. Girls wearing Summer dresses should avoid spaghetti straps and have shoulders covered if possible.

Our policies state that our expectation is that children should have sun cream liberally applied to any exposed areas **<u>before</u>** arriving at Playgroup. Some older children have extra in their rucksacks which they can apply later in the day if needed. We always keep sun cream at Playgroup and our policies state that any child we felt needed it, would have some applied by us, rather than stop them accessing the outdoors.

Water bottles should contain water rather than juice and we will always top up if empty.

May Day

We are waiting to hear from St Margaret's about what their celebrations will be and when. We usually join in with our older children starting the proceedings with a dance. More info to follow but this is often on the last day of half term.

Fees

Most families access or will access some sort of government funding but for those that do not, there will be a fee increase from £5.50 to £6 per hour from September 2024. This is still a very competitive rate compared to many other providers but unfortunately necessary, due to economic factors.
