

We are looking forward to all of our children watching this fascinating process and to soon be having baby ducklings splashing around in our water play areas.

When the ducklings are large enough, we are passing them on to experienced homes.

Pirate Day (all day) - Thursday 24th June

Please send your children dressed as Pirates, unless they don't want to, which is fine. We will be joined by one of the St Margaret's Reception classes in the morning and the other one in the afternoon.

We will have some pirate tattoos so please let us know if you do not want your child to have one.

This is a busy day so it would be great to have a couple of parent volunteers to help, both am & pm to maybe apply the tattoos or similar activities outside. If you are prepared to dress up as a pirate, wear a face mask and assist with some outdoor activities, then please let Sue know A.S.A.P.



P.E Week (pm only) - Monday 5th - Friday 9th July This week is designed to help children know they can change clothes and back again in preparation for school, more than the physical aspect, which is already covered every day.

If your child attends afternoon sessions and is in their last year before Reception, then please bring a named bag which can be kept on their peg all week, with a t-shirt, shorts & plimsolls / trainers to change into. Please name everything as changing time can be chaotic!

If your child does extended hours but is not in their last year, then you do not needs to bring in their P.E kit however, they will still be participating in our extra P.E activities.

Last Day of Term - Thursday 22nd July 2021

Children leaving us for Reception today (and extended hours that stay to lunch) may bring in a special 'party lunch' today.

After lunch, we will be joined by "Magic Marty" who is going to entertain the children with a magic show from around 1.30pm - 2.30pm.

If your child is in their last year with us but does not usually attend on a Thursday afternoon, then they are welcome to join us from 1.20pm, at no charge. Please fill in the slip and return it A.S.AP. If this applies.

September Start

We are having a Staff Inset Training day on Monday 6th September and will be returning for the children on **Tuesday 7th September 2021**.

For those going on to St Margaret's Reception classes, we know they have a very staggered start for the first couple of weeks. We therefore, offer a service aimed at working parents. If you wish to book your child in for



any sessions during these first couple of weeks from Tuesday 7th September, then they may be purchased. We charge £15 per session (£30 for the day). This cannot include taking children to and from Reception class visits.

Other Matters

Learning Journals - St Margaret's do not want to use our journals and will only be taking the children's Progress Review and Moving On sheets. Therefore, we will be passing these on to you in the last week, as a lovely record of your child's time and many achievements with us. If they are not going to St Margaret's we will liaise with feeder schools and also pass back to you if not required.

Book Bags - We try to reuse and recycle our book bags as your child will soon be receiving a new one from their feeder schools. The last day we will 'change' books is Friday 9th July and from then on ask that you return them with the last choice of book.

Sunny Weather

Another reminder to put suncream on before arrival please. Named sunhat for your child and sensible cool protective clothes (strappy dresses can lead to burnt shoulders). Morning children we will provide with drinks. All day and afternoon children can ask for their water bottles to be refilled or milk at any time.
